### **WEEKLY ORGANICS**

- » Remove all packaging from food and place scraps in kitchen bin.
- » Wrap organics in newspaper, use paper or certified compostable bags look for these logos:
- » Empty kitchen bin into organics cart frequently.

#### **FOOD WASTE**

- · Tea bags, coffee grounds, and filters
- Corn cobs and husks
- · Eggs and egg shells
- · Grease and fat
- · Halloween pumpkins
- · Meat, fish, and bones
- · Nuts and shells





#### **SOILED PAPER PRODUCTS**

- Pizza boxes
- · Waxed paper
- · Microwave popcorn bags
- Paper cups (loose not stacked)
- · Paper plates, paper towels and tissues
- · Fast food drink containers

# **PET WASTE** · Household pet feces

- Kitty litter (no plastic kitty litter liners)
- · Hamster/guinea pig cage bedding (wood and cedar shavings)
- Newspaper from bottom of bird cages

#### **OTHER ITEMS**

- Cold wood ashes (wet and in a compostable bag)
- Drver lint
- · Feathers and hair



#### DO NOT INCLUDE



- Plastic and Diapers
- Cigarette butts
- Feminine hygiene products
- · Leaf and yard waste
- Vacuum bags

# **BI-WEEKLY GARBAGE**

- » Excess garbage, set-out in addition to the garbage cart, must have a County garbage tag affixed.
- » Max. of 5 tagged standard size garbage bags permitted.
- » For a list of tag outlets visit, simcoe.ca
- All coffee disks and single-serve coffee pods (K-cups)



- Plastic bags and film (over wrap)
- · Styrofoam packaging and peanuts
- Black plastic



- · Plastic cutlery
- · Baby wipes and diapers
- · Dryer sheets



- · Feminine hygiene products
- Toys
- Textiles





- Vacuum bags
- Window glass (boxed and sealed)
- Wrappers (foil and plastic)
- Plastic corks

#### **DO NOT INCLUDE**



- Recyclable and organic materials
- Hazardous waste (medication, batteries, paint, etc.)
- Yard waste

Do NOT pack or overstuff carts, lids must be fully closed



## **BI-WEEKLY RECYCLING**

- » Check below to confirm if packaging is recyclable or visit simcoe.ca/wastewizard, please remove all food residue.
- » If quantities are larger, flatten and bundle (max.75x75x20cm) beside cart. Flatten cardboard and put inside the recycling cart\*.
- Place recyclables loose inside the cart, do NOT bag (exception shredded paper)
  - · Coffee and tea plastic lids

- · Plat pots and trays (no cell packs)
- · Aluminum Plates and Foil

· Glass bottles and jars



- Shredded paper \*must be placed in clear bag
- · Spiral-wound containers, Gable top and Tetra-pak<sup>™</sup> containers



- · Aerosol, beverage, and food cans
- · Paint cans (lids removed)



#### **DO NOT INCLUDE**



- Black plastic and Styrofoam
- · Plastic bags and film
- Drinking glasses and window glass
- · Ceramics and Plastic
- · Wrappers (candy and chips)
- · Motor oil bottles
- · LCBO and beer bottles
- Paper cups, paper plates and soiled paper
- · Tissues and paper towel
- · Waxed cardboard
- · Waxed or foil-coated paper
