



SUBJECT: COST FACTORS TO BE USED IN 2006 FISCAL YEAR BUDGETS FOR MUNICIPAL NON-PROFIT HOUSING CORPORATIONS.

The cost factor is a regional inflationary/deflationary factor which is used in the calculation of operating subsidy in the budgets of municipal non-profit housing corporations. The cost factor for each region is reviewed annually and adjusted in accordance with changes in the consumer price index for costs of housing operations.

This notification applies to municipal non-profit housing corporations currently under the administration by local service managers, the Ministry of Health and Long Term Care and the Ministry of Community and Social Services.

Non-Profit's Responsibility

All municipal non-profit housing corporations must use the cost factor specific to their region in the calculation of their operating subsidy for their fiscal year beginning 2006. The cost factor is used in line 432 and line 532 of the municipal non-profit operating budget for 819 (01/95). (e.g. 2.30% would be expressed as 1.0230).

Further instructions on budget preparation are provided in the ministry's publication A Guide For Non-Profit Housing Corporations Operating Budget and Annual Information Return, Non-Profit Housing Program, which was released in January 1995.
