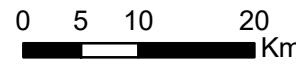
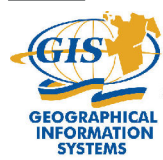
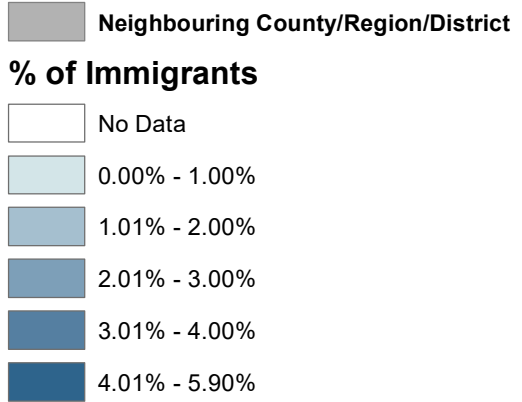

1. **Immigrants** (or foreign-born population) refers to a person who is, or who has ever been, a landed immigrant or permanent resident in Canada. Such a person has been granted the right to live in Canada permanently by immigration authorities. Immigrants who have obtained Canadian citizenship by naturalization are included in this group. In the 2016 Census of Population, 'Immigrants' includes immigrants who landed in Canada on or prior to May 10, 2016.

2. The **% of Total Population** shows the number of immigrants in a given geographical area divided by the total population living in the same geographical area.
