Occupied Private Dwellings by Period of Construction

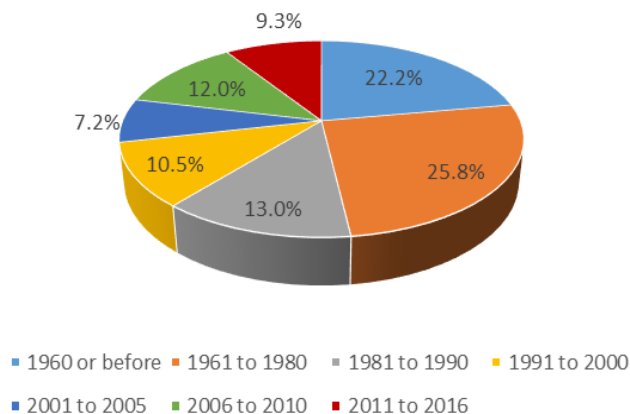


Figure 2: Current housing stock of the Town.

As per the County's Residential Land Budget 2019 the Town has a demand for approximately 3,910 units to accommodate the 2031 forecasted population. This would require the Town to add about 326 new units/year to meet this forecast. The Town is currently adding units at about 80% of that rate. (Table 2)
