Solutions Lab

Funded by the National Housing Strategy Solutions Labs, the Community Data Program (CDP) has teamed up with Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC) on a Solutions Lab.

The goal of this Solutions Lab is to help municipalities and community sector organizations find the best way to measure and respond to local housing and housing-related issues through relevant data, visualization and reporting tools.

The project is expected to span November 2020- March 2022 and occur in stages. The project is currently in the discovery stage which involved a survey of stakeholders which

was e-mailed out to all consortium members. The purpose of the survey was to determine priority housing and related urbanization/local development challenges, data gaps, and opportunity costs of missing data.

Input from a variety of organizations with diverse data needs will help ensure the outcomes of the solutions lab meet the variety of data needs across the Country.

Future involvement for interested consortium members and external agencies may include e-mails and/or surveys to collect feedback, discussion items added to the Extranet and possibly focus group discussions.
