- Understand what services immigrants would like to access within their communities.

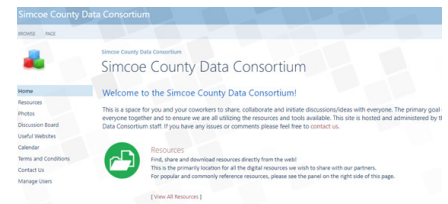

Highlights from a Crowdsourcing Questionnaire: Impacts of the COVID-19 Pandemic on Canadian Children with Cognitive, Behavioural or Emotional Disabilities

This data blog provides a snapshot of the experiences of parents who reported having children aged 0 to 14 years with cognitive, behavioural, or emotional disabilities during the early response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Comparisons are made to the experiences of parents who reported having children in the same age range with no disabilities.

Readers should note that data collected using crowdsourcing are not collected using a probability-based sampling design, therefore, findings cannot be generalized to the Canadian population overall.
