SCIF Overview



Purpose

Goals

 To help local organizations develop community-based initiatives that address poverty

- Address services for low income families, particularly those in receipt of social assistance
- Address pressures identified in the social service sector





The SCIF supports a variety of programs across Simcoe County:



SCIF Details



- The SCIF is 100% funded by the County of Simcoe
- The amount of funding may change year to year
 2017 = \$1.2M
- A community-based Allocations Committee reviews applications and provides funding recommendations
- Recommendations are approved by County Council
- Funding is for the calendar year (January to December)





Projects or programs that focus on:

- Preventing or breaking the cycle of poverty
- Supporting inclusive service strategies
- Community partnerships and collaborations
- Enhancing a culture of health and wellbeing
- Collective impact and sustainability

Applicants must:

- Be an incorporated non-profit
- Have a project mandate to provide opportunities for lowincome families and/or reduce the effects of child poverty
- Carry \$5,000,000 General Liability Insurance

The proposal must be submitted by a sponsoring agency willing to assume accountability for the funds


