



ACCESSING CHILD CARE FEE SUBSIDY

Choosing quality licensed child care will help your child learn and grow. You want your child to be safe and happy. A licensed child care program provides child care 12 months of the year. Some programs also offer part-time care, nursery school programs, and temporary care services. School-age programs are licensed to provide before and/or after school care, as well as care on professional development days and school holidays.

Financial assistance to help cover the cost of child care may be available through the County of Simcoe Children and Community Services Department. If we are in a wait-list situation, please call our office and add your name to our wait-list for child care fee assistance.

Financial need is determined through an income test.
