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Census 2016: Age and Sex

Key Points

- The 2016 Census reported 479,650 people residing in Simcoe County. Of this total, 79,100 (16.5%) were age 0-14, 58,220 (12.1%) were age 15-24, 55,585 (11.6%) were age 25-34, 58,560 (12.2%) were age 35-44, 72,810 (15.2%) were age 45-54, 69,160 (14.4%) were age 55-64, and 86,220 (18.0%) were over the age of 65.
- Municipalities with a higher proportion of seniors aged 65+ years compared to children aged 0-14 years include: Collingwood (26% and 14%, respectively), Midland (25% and 14%, respectively), Orillia (24% and 14%, respectively), Penetanguishene (24% and 13%, respectively), Ramara (26% and 12%, respectively), and Wasaga Beach (33% and 12%, respectively).
- Municipalities with a higher proportion of children aged 0-14 years compared to seniors aged 65+ years include: Barrie (18% an 14%, respectively), Bradford West Gwillimbury (20% and 11%, respectively), Christian Island (25% and 6%, respectively), Essa (19% and 10%, respectively), and Mnjikaning First Nation 32 (24% and 9%, respectively).
- Municipalities with the highest percent of population change include Bradford West Gwillimbury (+25.8%), Wasaga Beach (+17.9%), and Essa (+13.9%). Overall, the percent of population change for Simcoe County was +7.5% from 2011 to 2016.
- Seniors (65+ years) are the fastest growing population group in Simcoe County (+23%), followed by the age group of 55-64 years (+19%), and 25-34 years (+15%).
- The population in Simcoe County was composed by 51% of females and 49% of males in 2016.



Children (0-14 years) and Senior Population (65+ years)

The Proportion of Children and Senior Population in Simcoe County and Municipalities, 2016



The age structure of Simcoe County is changing. Some of the municipalities show disproportion between children (0-14 years) and seniors (65+ years).

Municipalities in which there is a higher proportion of seniors aged 65+ years compared to children 0-14 years include: Collingwood (26% compared to 14%), Midland (25% compared to 14%), Orillia (24% compared to 14%), Penetanguishene (24% compared to 13%), Ramara (26% compared to 12%), and Wasaga Beach (33% compared to 12%).

Municipalities in which there is a higher proportion of children aged 0-14 years compared to seniors 65+years include: Barrie (18% compared to 14%), Bradford (20% compared to 11%), Christian Island (25% compared to 6%), Essa (19% to 10%), and Mnjikaning First Nation 32 (24% compared to 9%).



Population Percent Change in the Last Five Years

Percent of Population Change by Age Groups in Simcoe County, 2011-2016



In the past five years (2011-2016) there was a 7.5% change in the population of Simcoe County overall. Seniors (65+ years) were the fastest growing population group in Simcoe County (+23.4%) followed by the age groups of 55-64 years (19.0%), 25-34 years (14.5%), and 0-14 years (3.6%). However, there was a decline in the percentage of population change in the age groups of 15-24 years (-1.1%), 35-44 years (-1.2%) and 45-54 years (-3.0%) compared to 2011.






Population Distribution by Age and Sex in Simcoe County, 2016

According to the 2016 Census, the population in Simcoe County is composed by 51% of female and 49% of male. There is a slight increase in the proportion of males compared to females in the age groups 0-4 years (2.6%), 5-9 years (2.9%), 10-14 years (2.9%), 15-19 years (3.1%), and 20-24 years (3.2%), while the female proportion compared to the male proportion tends to increase with age.





