Annual Meeting June 2 & 3rd, 2022


- Annual Report 2021-2022
 - Acquiring data around impacts of COVID-19, housing, immigration, and affordability
 - Tableau visualizations
 - Strong relationships with Statistics Canada and Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC)
 - Completion of Solutions Lab
 - Engagement of leads and data users in the Data Purchase and Access Working Group

CDP Leads Update

Annual Meeting June 2 & 3rd, 2022

- Statistics Canada Update
 - Custom Geography data expected early 2023
 - Gender variable replaced previous sex variable in standard tables
 - Detailed gender variables available for populations over 100,000 (Barrie CSD)
 - Change in Statistics Canada production system
 - Statistics Canada doesn't publish data quality and suppression rules
 - Collective dwelling data suppression has changed





Municipal Boundaries






