

ELECTRIC VEHICLE FAST-CHARGING STATIONS

Who can charge?

Any full electric vehicle with a Level 3 fast-charging port can use the stations (e.g. Nissan Leaf, Chevrolet Bolt, Hyundai Ioniq). Tesla drivers can charge with a Tesla adapter.

Plug-in hybrid electric vehicles with Level 2 ports (e.g. Chevrolet Volt) <u>cannot</u> use the stations.

What is the cost?

Charging is \$0.25 per minute* *2018-19 rates. Fees subject to change as hydro rates increase.

How do I pay to start a charge?

- 1. Swipe your credit card at the station or call Greenlots at 1-855-900-7584 to process.
- 2. Use the Greenlots mobile app. The app can be downloaded in advance and pre-loaded with your payment information.
