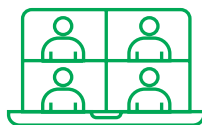

How Survey Mode and Survey Context Affect the Measurement of Self-Perceived Racial Discrimination across Cycles of the General Social Survey

This paper discusses how the survey topic (social identification vs victimization) and survey methodology (computer assisted telephone interviews vs self-completed electronic questionnaire) impact rating of self-perceived racial discrimination on Statistics Canada's General Social Survey. 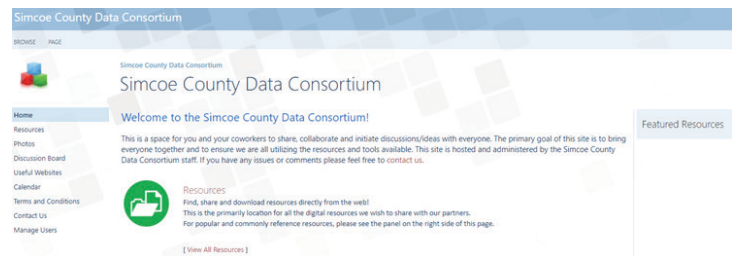
