Funded by the National Housing Strategy Solutions Labs, the Community Data Program (CDP) has teamed up with Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC) on a Solutions Lab.

The goal of this Solutions Lab is to help municipalities and community sector organizations find the bestway to measure and respond to local housing and housing-related issues through relevant data, visualization and reporting tools.
