County Initiated Official Plan Amendment – Environmental Resource Recovery Centre

### **PROPOSAL**

The County of Simcoe adopted a Solid Waste Management Strategy in 2010 that provides the framework for the County's waste disposal options and diversion programs. Guided by the Strategy, and following further recommendations from Council, the County initiated a siting process in 2014 to identify a site for the development

of an Organics Processing Facility (OPF) for the long-term processing of source-separated organics (SSO). The siting process was subsequently expanded to also identify a site for the development of a Materials Management Facility (MMF) for the transfer of garbage, recyclables, and SSO. Collectively, these facilities are referred to as the Environmental Resource Recovery Centre (ERRC).

An extensive site evaluation process was undertaken which considered 502 candidate sites. Two key components used in assessing potential sites involved evaluation criteria for site screening and extensive public consultation. Of 502 sites evaluated, 7 sites were short listed for the OPF and 5 sites were short listed for the MMF, which were also suitable for co-located sites. The shortlisted sites were subjected to further assessment involving analysis of the net effects of the use at each location. A comparative evaluation of the findings of this assessment resulted in the recommendation that the property located at 2976 Horseshoe Valley Road in the Township of Springwater within Lot 2, Concession 1, was the preferred site. The subject lands are approximately 84 hectares (207.6 acres) in size and the approximate footprint of the ERRC is estimated at 4.5 hectares (11.12acres).

To facilitate the development of the ERRC, amendments are required to both the County of Simcoe and the Township of Springwater Official Plans as well as the Township of Springwater Comprehensive Zoning By-law. The County has submitted official plan and zoning by-law amendment applications to the Township of Springwater which are currently subject to the planning review process.

The County is proposing to amend the Official Plan for the County of Simcoe by:

- 1. Modifying Schedule 5.6.1, by a) renaming Schedule 5.6.1 "County Waste Disposal Sites" to Schedule 5.6.1 "County Waste Management System", b) adding Environmental Resource Recovery Centre to the legend, and c) adding a symbol for Environmental Resource Recovery Centre to the Schedule within Part of Lot 2, Concession 1, Township of Springwater; and,
- 2. Adding the following section and text after Section 4.9.17, Section 4.9.18, Environmental Resource Recovery Centre Part of Lot 2, Concession 1, Springwater (2976 Horseshoe Valley Road) Permitted uses on a portion of Part of Lot 2, Concession 1, Springwater Township (2976 Horseshoe Valley Road) as identified on Schedule 5.6.1 as Environmental Resource Recovery Centre shall include facilities for the purpose of the consolidation and transfer of various waste streams such as organics, recyclable materials and non-hazardous household garbage, processing of organic green bin materials under controlled conditions for conversion into other materials. Other ancillary uses would include a public education area, truck maintenance and servicing area and facility administration area. The temporary storage of waste is permitted on the lands but no permanent disposal of waste materials or landfilling of any kind is permitted with the lands subject to Section 4.9.18.

**THE PURPOSE** of the County initiated amendment is to modify Schedule 5.6.1 of the County Official Plan by renaming the schedule from 'County Waste Disposal Sites' to 'County Waste Management System', adding 'Environmental Resource Recovery Centre' to the map legend and adding a symbol for 'Environmental Resource Recovery Centre' to the Schedule on a portion of the subject lands. The proposed amendment will also add a new site specific section of text after Section 4.9.17 detailing the permitted uses and associated development parameters on the site.

**THE EFFECT** of the amendment is to facilitate the development of an Environmental Resource Recovery Centre that includes an Organics Processing Facility for the long-term processing of source-separated organics, a Materials Management Facility for the transfer of garbage, recyclables and source-separated organics, a potential future Materials Recovery Facility, and ancillary uses.

**ANY PERSON OR PUBLIC BODY** may attend the Public Meeting and make written and/or verbal representation either in support of, or in opposition to the proposed Official Plan Amendment. If any person or public body wishes to register their intent to make verbal representation at the public meeting, written notice should be provided to the County Clerk.

The approval authority for County of Simcoe Official Plan amendments is the Ministry of Municipal Affairs.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the County of Simcoe before the proposed Official Plan Amendment is adopted, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing to the Ontario Municipal Board.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the County of Simcoe before the proposed Official Plan Amendment is adopted, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.


