- Since the last meeting on June 15, there has been one meeting on June 20th, 2023
- Updates:
- 2021 Census
 - Custom geography table production:
 - Census Profile
 - Age and Gender
 - Target Group Profiles
- Possibility of acquiring Disability Tax Credit Statistics data at smaller geographies*
 - *currently available at provincial level

- Preparation for Household and Family Target Group Profiles (expected 2024)
- Received data on permanent residents from IRCC
 - At CD and CSD level
- Acquisition of IRCC temporary resident data in the works
- Possible Collaboration with UBC for Housing Assessment Resource Tools (HART)
