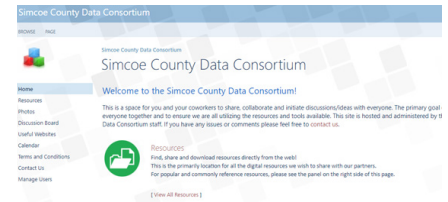

Longitudinal Administrative Databank (LAD)

The LAD is a database which links together years of taxfiles for a 20% sample of the Canadian population. This allows for research on trends in income over time as well as variation by

demographics.

On June 11, 2021 Statistics Canada released The Daily article *Study: Lone-parent families, older people and people living alone are more likely to remain in low income, 2018* and the Income Research Paper Series *Low-income*

persistence in Canada and the provinces.

On January 10, 2023 the CDP acquired three excel tables at the CD and CSD level detailing low income persistence of tax filers, low income entry and exit rates of tax filers and

low income duration of tax filers.
