### 1. Welcome and Introductions

Group shared the current projects they were working on. Topics included geocoding, developing strategies, working with census data, collecting labour market information and creating client data profiles.

## 2. CDP Updates

### a. Leads update

Victoria provided updates detailed in the attached PowerPoint.

Group discussed their experience with Environics Analytics data. Some members mentioned using population forecasts between Census years and Prizm data to

understand clients. As well understanding possible clients within specific driving times from services and publishing some data publicly was also discussed.

# b. Data Purchasing and Access Working group meeting updates

Victoria provided updates from the working group detailed in the attached PowerPoint.

**Action:** Victoria to send out information to the group on the webinar in May where Statistics Canada staff will be discussing possible options for mitigating the impact of COVID supports on income data and indicators from the 2021 Census.

The group is interested in CDP Tableau dashboards providing more information on housing data and changes in the renter profile such as information on those in the middle income range due to interest rates and housing prices.

Other members were interested in gaining access to seasonal resident data, any changes to low-income methodology and sharing information on the living wage for 2022 which was \$20.70 per hour for the economic zone of Bruce, Grey, Perth, Huron and Simcoe.

Action: Victoria will follow up on when new Building Permit data will be available.

**Update:** 2022 Building Permit data will be available from Statistics Canada in June. Still waiting for an update on 2021 Building Permit data.
