

ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS

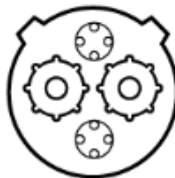
Who can charge?

Level 3 - Fully electric vehicles with a DC fast-charging ports. Tesla drivers can charge with a Tesla adapter.

Level 2 - Any electric vehicle sold in North America can use Level 2 stations across Canada and the US. This includes Battery Electric Vehicles (BEV) and Plug-in Hybrid Electric Vehicles (PHEV).

What is the cost?

2023-2024 Rates

Level 3

\$15 per hour (\$0.25/minute)

Level 2

\$1.50 per hour (\$0.03/minute)

How do I pay to start a charge?

1. Tap your credit card at the station
2. Use the FLO app. The app can be downloaded in advance and pre-loaded with your payment information.



How long will it take?

LEVEL 3 - Recharge battery life from 0-80% under an hour

LEVEL 2 - Recharge battery life between 6-10 hours to fully charge a BEV and 4-8 hours to charge a PHEV

Recharge time may vary depending on vehicle make and model.

Can the station be used in rain & snow?

Yes, the station is safe to use in all weather conditions, but charging may be slower in cold or hot conditions.

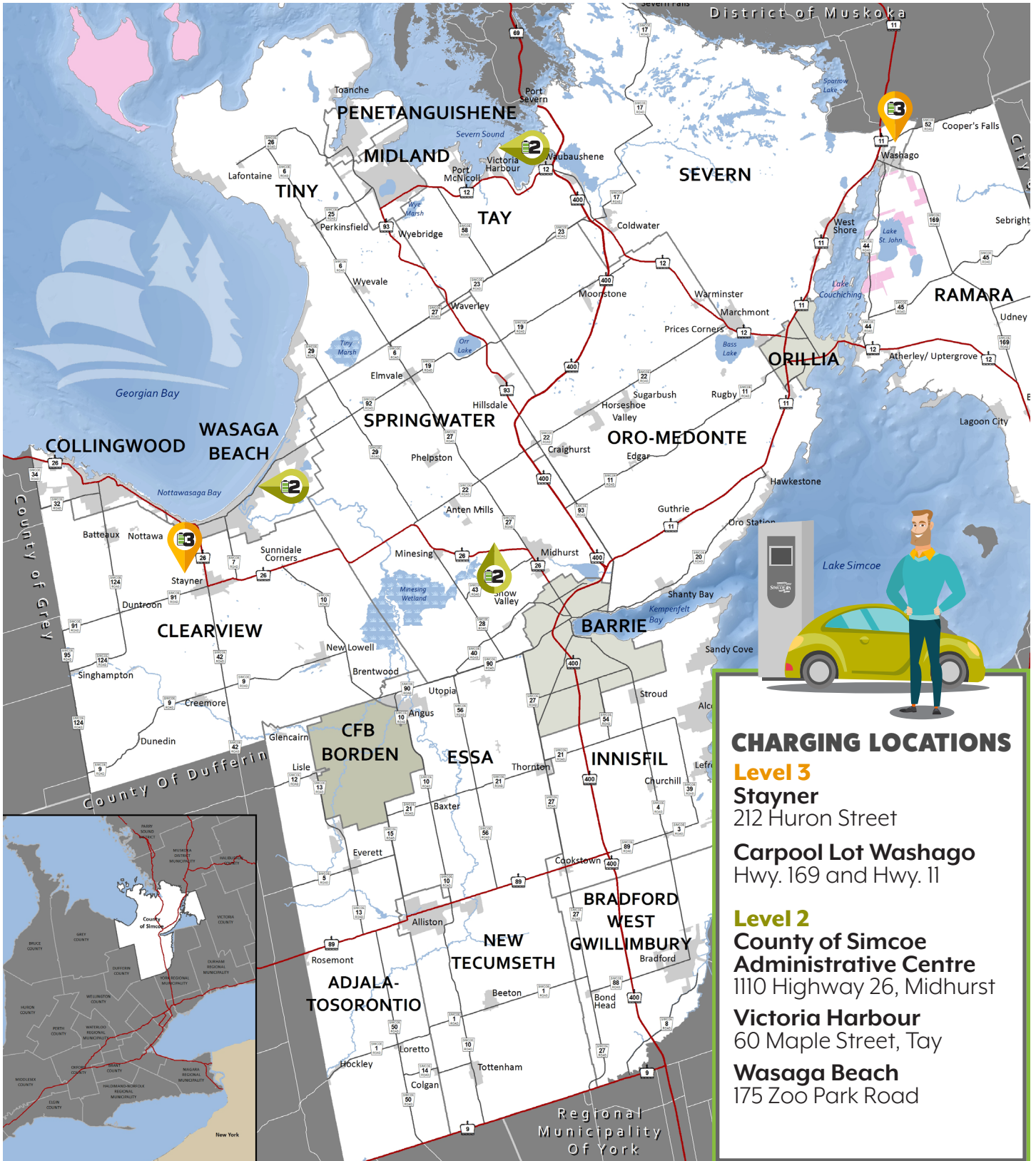
