

# Notice of Study Commencement – County Road 29 and 22



# The Study:

The County of Simcoe (County) together with their Consultant, D. M. Wills Associates Ltd. (Wills), is undertaking a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MCEA) to assess the need for intersection enhancements at County Road 22 (Horseshoe Valley Rd) and County Road 29 (Crossland Rd) in the Township of Springwater. Options will be reviewed and evaluated during the Study to determine a preferred solution. Each option will consider social, environmental, operational, and financial implications. The study area is generally outlined in red on **Figure 1**.
