How to Analyze:

1. Quickly scan the photo. What do you notice first?:

2. Type of Photo (check all the apply):
 - Portrait** (photograph of a person or group of people that captures the personality of the subject)
 - Landscape** (a photo that captures nature and the natural world)
 - Aerial/satellite** (these photos are taken from an aircraft, satellite or other flying objects like a drone)
 - Action** (a still photo that shows someone or something in motion)
 - Architectural** (photos of buildings and different structures)

- Event** (this type of photography is done of guests and occurrences at any event or occasion where one may hire a photographer for)
- Family** (these photos are all about capturing groups of people that have family ties. These range from the small group, such as parents and their children)
- Panoramic** (this is a technique of photography, using specialized equipment or software, that captures images with horizontally elongated fields of view)
- Posed** (the people in these photos have been put into a certain pose and hold that stance while the photo is taken. Often, the subject is looking directly at the camera, and there is no movement)
- Candid** (this is a type of photo that is captured without creating a posed appearance)
- Documentary** (this type of photography is used to chronicle events or environments both significant and relevant to history and historical events as well as everyday life)
- Selfie** (this is a self-portrait digital photograph)
