## To designate April 14 to 20, 2024 as National Volunteer Week

Whereas 24 million Canadians give their time through formal or informal types of volunteering, contributing close to 5 billion volunteer hours per year; and

Whereas volunteers in Simcoe County mentor our children, feed our hungry, comfort our lonely, beautify our green spaces, and fundraise for our charitable organizations; and

Whereas volunteers in Simcoe County continue to support families, friends, neighbours, and strangers, people standing up to systemic racism, and people sharing insights on how to create a more just and equitable society; and

Whereas Simcoe County's volunteers are individuals, families, workers, retirees, community members of all ages and backgrounds; and

Whereas the collective result of the work done by our County's volunteers is that Simcoe County is a more desirable place to live; and

Whereas, organizations in Simcoe County that rely on volunteers include such fundamental organizations as local hospitals, schools, hospices, community centres, sports programs, charities, and more; and

Therefore I, Ovarden Basil Clarke, on behalf of Simcoe County Council, do hereby proclaim the week of April 14 to 20, 2024, as "National Volunteer Week" in the County of Simcoe and urge my fellow citizens to recognize the crucial role played by volunteers in our community.
