- Business licensing concerns
- Other by-law-related matters

Call **1-800-222-8477** for Crime Stoppers to report illegal/criminal activities of a non-emergency nature.



You need to tell the call-taker

- Who you are: your name/contact information.
- What is happening.
- Where is it happening, and where you are.
- When this is happening (now, or how often with the time of day).
- Do you have proof? Photos/ videos of what happened, or/and a record of multiple times the same thing has happened.
