

Data Purchase and Access Working Group (DPAWG) Meetings

COUNTY OF

- Since our last meeting (Nov 16, 2024), there have been two DPAWG meetings (Nov 28, 2023 & Jan 30, 2024)
- Updates:
 - Rural Community Workforce Development Data Portal added to CDP
 - The IRCC Temporary Residents data request has been submitted
 - 2015-2022 data at the CD- and CSD-level for 21 tables
 - IRCC Permanent Residents data will be requested to be updated with 2023 data
 - Responses from IRCC to be acquired regarding definitions, methodology, transition rates/information, and data timelines.
 - 2022 Canadian Disability Survey data tables at lower-level (CD-CSD) geographies order in process
 - Goal of CDP expanding to rural and remote Canadian areas

- Data expected to be acquired in 2024 from:
 - Statistics Canada
 - Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC)
 - IRCC
 - Provincial Health Ministries
 - Employment & Social Development Canada
 - Maytree
 - Canada Post
