Town By-Law Enforcement and Municipal Works

The Town of Midland will investigate complaints, but sometimes they may not be able to respond immediately. If it keeps happening, with a pattern call **705-526-4275 ext. 2255**.

Town By-law will gather proof to take appropriate action.

- Noise disturbances (at any time)
- Illegal parking
- Property maintenance issues
- Activities in public spaces
- Business licensing concerns
- Other by-law-related matters



Community Connection 2-1-1

24/7 information and referral service to connect with government and community-based, non-clinical health and social services. 211 services are free and confidential.

Non-Emergencies call **888-310-1122**

Reporting of illegal activities that are not urgent. Police can write tickets for many nuisances.

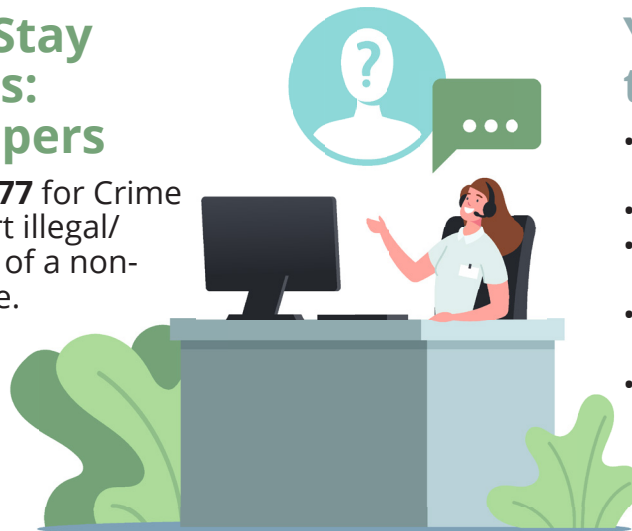


EMERGENCIES call **9-1-1**

For Ontario Provincial Police (OPP), a Fire Truck or an Ambulance for critical incidents affecting safety, or illegal/criminal activities for immediate response.

Privacy to Stay Anonymous: Crime Stoppers

Call **1-800-222-8477** for Crime Stoppers to report illegal/criminal activities of a non-emergency nature.



You need to tell the call-taker

- Who you are: your name/contact information.
- What is happening.
- Where is it happening, and where you are.
- When this is happening (now, or how often with the time of day).
- Do you have proof? Photos/videos of what happened, or/and a record of multiple times the same thing has happened.
